The Grassland Improvement Program is a program being offered in Adams, Franklin, Harlan, Kearney, Phelps and Webster counties to improve the health and diversity of grasslands. This is a partnership with Pheasants Forever, Quail Forever, Nebraska Partnership for All-bird Conservation, Nebraska Environmental Trust and the Nebraska Game & Parks Commission. Landowners accepted in the program receive an incentive of a \$30 per acre payment to defer the grazing on enrolled grasslands for one calendar year when a prescribed burn and other grassland improvements are performed on the grassland in the following year.
