



South Central Nebraska Prescribed Burn Association

Bylaws

1. Annual Membership is maintained by paying an annual membership fee of \$25.00 and either attending one burn training per year endorsed by the South Central Nebraska Prescribed Burn Association (SCNPBA) or participating in one SCNPBA burn project per year.
2. SCNPBA members must participate in a minimum of 2 (two) SCNPBA or other association burns before a burn can be conducted on their property. Officers and board members may waive this requirement for active SCNPBA members.
3. SCNPBA officers and board members must approve all burn plans. Approval is by simple majority of the officers and board members.
4. A minimum level of prescribed burn training and certification is required to use
5. SCNPBA burn equipment. This minimum level of training will consist of attendance at an endorsed burn school and participation in a minimum of 2 (two) prescribed burns. The training will be offered annually and provided by approved resource agency personnel. Upon completion of prescribed burn training and current membership status, a SCNPBA certification card will be issued. This card will be required to check out and use SCNPBA equipment.
6. SCNPBA equipment will be stored and checked out at the Bloomington Fire Barn in Franklin County.
7. All checks written from the SCNPBA account will require two signatures of SCNPBA officers.
8. There can be Spring burns and Fall burns. Burn plans should be submitted annually to the address listed below by March 1 for 2009 and by February 1 for subsequent years for approval. Burn plans may be submitted after these dates, but plans submitted by these dates will receive first priority.
